Dr. Brainard O. Hawk

Dr. Brainard Hawk was a native of Rumersburg, Pa. A well-known surgeon in the Pittsburgh area, Hawk was chairman of the Department of Obstetrics at Allegheny General Hospital, and he served as a consultant on the staffs of both Sewickley Valley Hospital and North Hills Passavant Hospital.

A recipient of the First Obstetrical Prize at University of Pennsylvania in 1938, he was listed in both *Medical Specialists* and *American Men of Medicine*, both well-known directories. Hawk was a member of the International College of Surgeons, the American College of Surgeons, American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, Pittsburgh Academy of Medicine, Pittsburgh College of Obstetrics and Gynecologists, American Medical Association, Pennsylvania Medical Society and Allegheny county Medical Society.

He passed away July 30, 1995.
