Robb Jones, in 1991, was chosen from more than 500 candidates to serve as chief of staff to Chief Justice William Rehnquist of the United States Supreme Court. His responsibilities included working with Congress and the Executive Branch on items concerning the effective administration of justice.

Following his Supreme Court service, he ran education programs for federal Judges at the Federal Judicial Center. Since 1997 he has been sentor vice-president and general counsel at United Educators, a reciprocal risk retention group owned by over 1200 colleges, universities and K-12 schools.
