Allegheny County, Pa., native Robert Meneilly joined the American Can Company in 1930 as a supervisor of the Metals Group. He later worked with Carnegie-Illinois Steel Corporation as assistant to the chief metallurgical engineer. Meneilly moved up to metallurgical engineer, Tin Plate Division, at Carnegie-Illinois in 1940; assistant to the manager, Tin Plate Division, in 1952; and manager, Tin Plate Products, in 1958.

Meneilly then joined U.S. Steel Corporation as general operations manager, Tin Mill Products, in 1959 and became the general manager, Tin Mill Products, in 1964.

He was a member of the American Society Testing Materials, American Society of Metals and American Iron and Steel Institute.

He formerly chaired the Tin Plate Producers Committee of the Institute.

He was active in United Presbyterian Church, U.S.A., events and served on the board of national missions of the church. He moved to Naples, Fla., in 1987.

He passed away March 6, 2004.
