Having been inspired at Grove City College to join the business world, Donna Moraz was hired after graduation by privately held Cargill, Inc., of Minneapolis as an outside sales rep for their Ithino Hyde department. Selling products specifically marketed to grain elevators, Moraz spent her career traveling across the United States and Canada as one of the first women in outside sales of grain-handling equipment.

Mentored by her father Wesley '49, she was encouraged to pursue a solo entrepreneurial career in 1991 when she formed Deelross Company, Inc., which supplies capital project and maintenance equipment to grain-handling facilities.

As an active participant for 35 years in the Grain Elevator and Processing Society (GEAPS), Moraz served on the GEAPS Minneapolis Chapter board of directors and the International GEAPS Associates board of directors. She received the Minneapolis Chapter Member of Distinction award in 1997.

Branching out beyond Deelross Company, Moraz founded the start-up Mass Flow Sourcing in 2013. Located in Lake Crystal, Minn., the new company is a stocking distributor for ANDCO Eagle actuators manufactured by General Electric in Houston, Texas.

Moraz served on the Grove City College Alumni Council from 1998 to 2000, as well as on the Grove City College Entrepreneurship Advisory Council, from 2002 to 2004. She is currently an active owner and sales manager of both Deelross Company, Inc., and Mass Flow Sourcing. Moraz splits her time between Minnetonka, Minn., in the summer and Henderson, Nev., during the winter.
