For 40 years, Robert L. Nutt practiced corporate and commercial law with the firm of Ropes & Gray in Boston. Engaged in corporate, securities and commercial law practice, Nutt became a partner at Ropes & Gray in 1979. He represented, among others, The First National Bank of Boston, Berkshire Hathaway Inc., Short Brothers PLC, Merrill Lynch Private Equity and the New England Patriots Football Club.

He served for many years on the ABA committee on corporate laws, and chaired the Corporation Law section of the Boston Bar Association and the Business Law section of the Massachusetts Bar Association. As an adjunct professor, he taught corporate finance at the Boston University School of Law. In addition, he was on the faculty of numerous continuing legal education programs sponsored by the Practising Law Institute, Massachusetts Continuing Legal Education, Inc., and various bar associations. He co-chaired the Task Force on the Comprehensive Revision of the Massachusetts Business Corporate Law and was a co-author of the annual supplements of the Aspen Law and Business volume, Massachusetts Corporate Law and Practice.

Nutt has also been involved with his community as trustee and counsel for the Shore County Day School and as trustee and moderator of the First Church of Christ. He now owns and operates Lacey Creek Livestock LLC, a registered angus outfit in north central Montana. He is a Trustee Emeritus on the Grove City College Board of Trustees.
