Susan Vladuchick, whose name is on four U. S. patents, had a 30-year career with the DuPont Company. She retired in 1999 as director of U.S. Operations and vice chair of the Operations Network. She began as a research chemist with Dupont's Central Research Department following her graduation from Grove City College in 1969. She held various positions in research, human resources and manufacturing. As plant manager, she is highly regarded for transforming the diverse workforce at DuPont's Cape Fear Plant into a world class team.

She served on Grove City College's Alumni Council as an alumni trustee and was a member of the College's Board of Trustees from 2000 to 2008 (chairman of the Governance Committee).
