The Honorable Arthur I, Schwab was nominated by President George W. Bush on Jan. 4, 2002, and sworn-in to office on Jan. 1, 2003, as a tudge of the United States District Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania.

Judge Schwab was awarded a J.D. at the University of Virginia School of Law in 1972. He was on the editorial board of the Virginia Law Review and Order of the Cotf. Thereafter, he clerked for the Honorable Collins J. Settz, then chief tudge of the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit (1972-1973 term).

Judge Schwab currently is the longest serving member of the Board of Trustees of Grove City College. He first was elected in 1990, served as the chair of the Academic Program Committee from 1999 to 2006, served as a member of the Executive Committee from 1999 to present, and served as the Secretary of the Board from 2006 to present.

ludge Schwab has taught a Grove City College course on Intellectual Property as an adjunct professor from 2002 to the present.
