## Dr. James D. Storey

## Class of 1961

Dr. James Storey held the positions of medical director for a large private pathology laboratory, three hospital staff appointments in metropolitan Milwaukee, associate clinical professor of pathology at the Medical College of Wisconstn, a Naval Reservist with the rank of captain in the Medical Corps and a flight surgeon for Patrol Squadron 60 at the Glenview (IIL) Naval Air Station. In addition, he was a school board director and treasurer, author and lectures.

Upon graduation from Grove City College, Storey entered the School of Medicine of the University of Pitisburgh. He graduated from there in 1965. During the next five years, he interned and completed a residency in pathology. He also was a fellow of the Sarah Melion Scatle Foundation in experimental pathology with particular emphasis in the field of immunopathology. His taught and lectured throughout his medical career. He instructed courses in pathology, clinical pathology and medicine at Marquette University and the Medical College of Wisconstin.



At the time of his award, while teaching and practicing medicine, Storey was medical director for a private pathology laboratory in Milwaukee supporting three large metropolitan Milwaukee hospitals.

He passed away Sept. 15, 1992.
