Dr. Randall Wilber is a senior sport physiologist at the U.S. Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs, Colo. He has worked with Olympic athletes and has been a staff member of Team USA at eight Olympic Games. In addition, he serves as a consultant to the U.S. Navy SEALs on issues related to combat performance at high altitude.

In the area of scholarship, Wilber has authored more than 50 papers in peer-reviewed scientific journals, and has written two books and several book chapters in the areas of sports medicine and sport science. In addition, he has been an invited speaker at scientific meetings across the globe. Wilber was recognized as a fellow of the American College of Sports Medicine (ACSM) in 1998 and currently serves as chair of the ACSM Olympic and Paralympic Sports Medicine Committee.
